This Level 1/Level 2 Vocational Award in Constructing the Built Environment is designed to support learners to develop an awareness of construction processes. It supports students who want to learn about the construction industry from the build perspective. It provides learners with a broad introduction to the different trades involved in the sector, the importance of safety and security, and the types of career opportunities available. It is mainly suitable as a foundation for further study, and on completion learners may wish to start an apprenticeship or continue in full-time education.

Students will have the opportunity to work in three practical disciplines from; Carpentry & Joinery, Electrical, Plumbing, Bricklaying, Tiling and Painting & Decorating.
