



A parent's guide to using INSIGHT for parents' evening bookings and video-conferencing

N.B. The instructions below will work on tablets/laptops or mobile phones. You do not need to download a mobile app. Access to the INSIGHT software is via the link on our website (the INSIGHT icon is shown above).

Step 1: Logging on

Logon to INSIGHT through your device. If you are unsure where to find INSIGHT, the logo connecting you to the software is available on the AGS website (select the 'Pastoral' tab, then 'INSIGHT'. Scroll down the webpage until you see the ICON at the top of this page).

On your landing page click the down arrow on the 'Information' tab





Step 3: making a booking with a teacher

If you would like a pdf of your booking list, select the 'Download' button above your booking list:



Step 5: connecting to a teacher

- Once the booking period is complete, the school will close the booking system to parents; at this point you will no longer be able to make or amend bookings
- On the date of the parents' evening, logon to the system and access your booking list by following the steps above
- Note: a video icon has now appeared at the right-hand side of each appointment

- At the allocated time, click the video icon and a new screen will open. This is the screen where you will meet the teacher (see screenshot below).
- When both you and the teacher have selected the video icon the green 'Connect' button will appear. Select this button to connect to the teacher. If either you or the teacher are late to the call, the 'Connect' button will not appear.



Step 6: ending the call

 To end the call, click the 'Hang Up' button located at the bottom of the video-conferencing screen. You will then be returned to the booking screen to take part in your next appointment.

Time is limited so please be mindful the teacher will have to limit to the 5 minutes allocated.

What if I or the school experience technical difficulties

We will do our very best to ensure the evening is successful. We are hopeful that all will go well. If you should experience problems with a connection (we are dependent on our broadband connection as are you), then please let us know and we will arrange for the teacher to contact you over the coming days.

Practical tips:

- Choose a location where the broadband or mobile phone signal is strong
- Make sure cameras are faced toward you and not forward facing (otherwise the member of staff will see your wallpaper and not you!!)
- Check your volume settings are on
- Are your security settings set to allow outgoing video broadcasts?
- Have a pen and paper handy if you want to record anything
- Remember the consultation will last 5 minutes and then the staff member will have to end the meeting to ensure they are able to connect to the next member of staff. - When the consultation takes place, please ensure the location is suitable
- Appropriate spaces may include main rooms in a household including dining rooms, lounge spaces and offices
