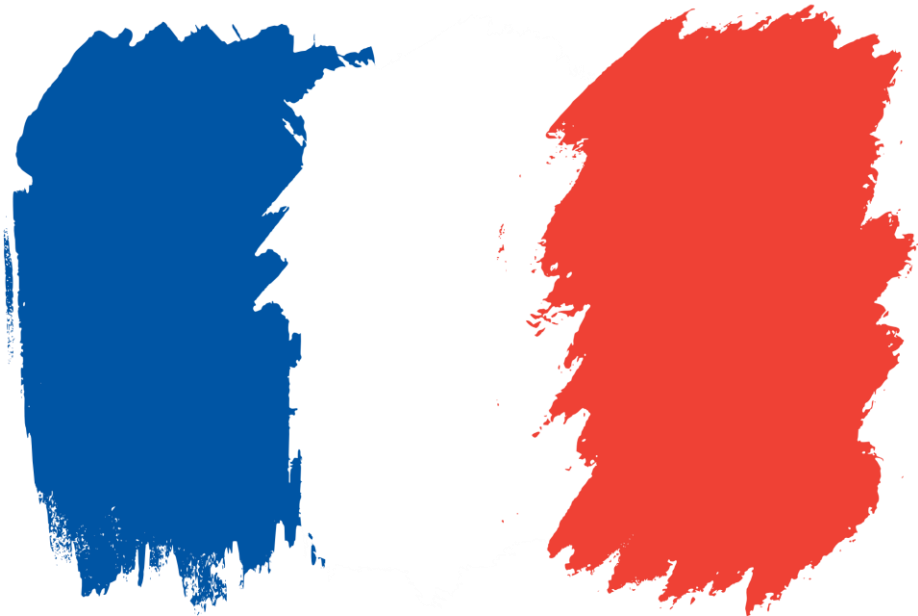

Summer Tasks 2022



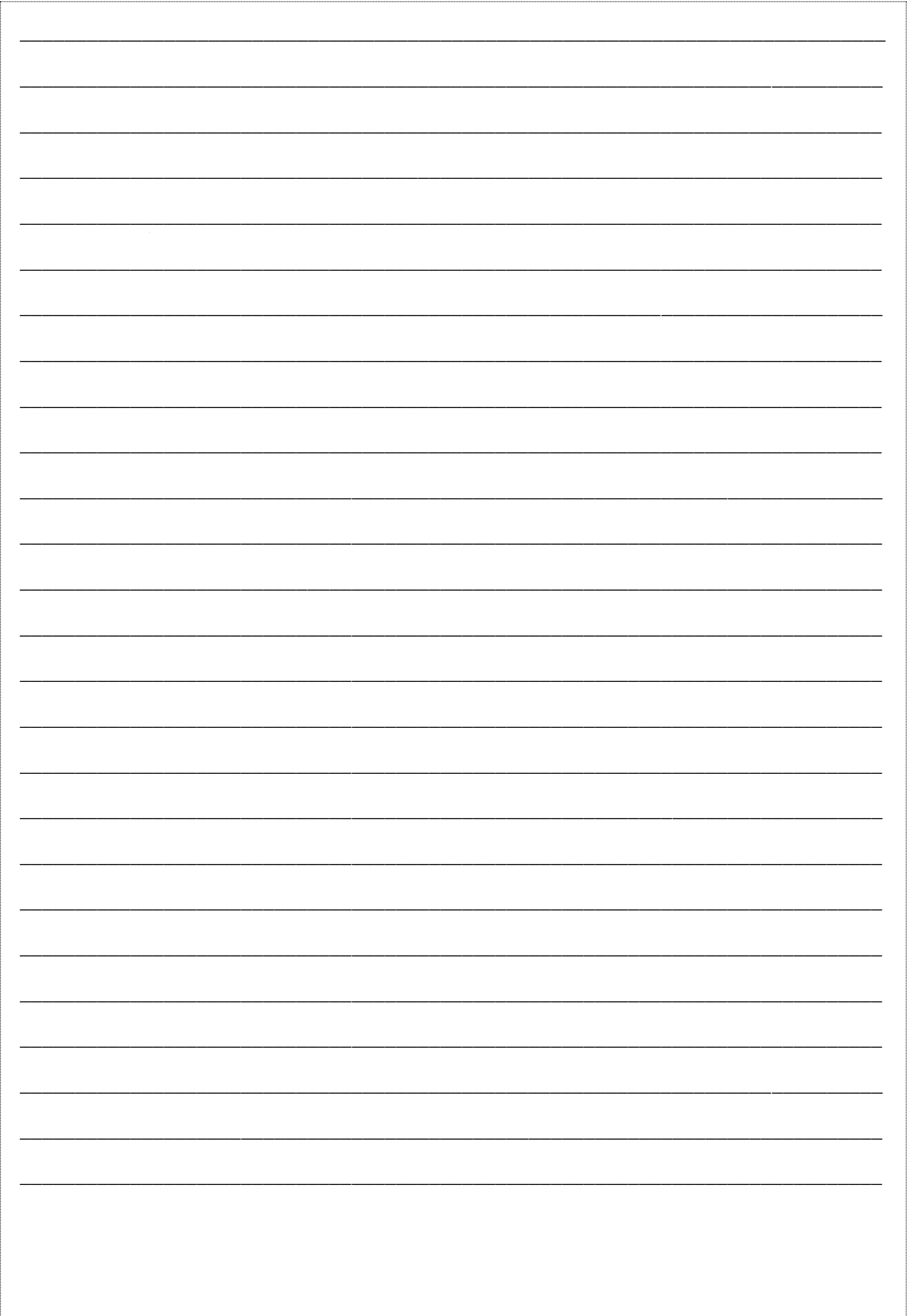
Over the holidays, please spend around one hour a week working on the tasks attached. You can choose which tasks to do, all of them will help you to bridge the gap between GCSE and AS French.
