- Provides would-be applicants and existing licence holders advice
- Grants licences
- Enforces licence conditions
- Write Policies

## What Activities Do We Licence?

- Alcohol, Entertainment and Late Night Refreshment
- Pubs, Clubs, Bars, Restaurants
- Music Festivals
- Music Concerts
- Theatres, Cinemas, Nightclubs
- Indoor Sports, Boxing, Wrestling
- Hot food and drink after 11pm and before 5am







#### · Taxis

- Hackneys that can be hailed in the street or pick up on a taxi rank
- Private Hire Vehicles (PHV) that must be pre-booked
- Taxi and PHV Drivers
- PHV Operators



- · Animal Welfare
- Dog Breeding
- Dog Boarding Kennels and Home Boarding
- Cat Boarding
- Pet Shops
- Hiring out of Horses
- Keeping of Animals for Training or Exhibition
- Dangerous Wild Animals
- Zoos





#### · Gambling Premises

- Bookmakers (Betting Shops)
- Race Tracks (Occasional Use)
- Amusement Arcades
- Adult Gaming Centres (larger pay-out machines - over 18s only)
- Raffles and Small Lotteries
- Amusement with Prizes Machines in Pubs & Clubs ("fruit machines")






- Scrap Metal Dealers

- Scrap Metal Collectors












- Cosmetic Piercing, Tattooing, Acupuncture
- Tattooing
- Ear Piercing
- Acupuncture
- Semi-Permanent Skin-Colouring
- Sex Establishments and Sex Entertainment Venues









- Selling of Goods or Services on the Public Highway, from a stall or a vehicle
   eg: takeaway food
- Caravan and Camping Sites
- Touring Sites
- Residential Sites
- Carvan/Holiday Park Homes





- House to House and Street Collections
- House to House Collections for Charities eg clothes, bric-a-brac etc
- Street Collections for Charities and good causes

eg Royal British Legion Poppy Day









### and finally .....

- Boatman and Boat Licences
- Boatman licences the driver of motorboats, pedalos, rowing boats, that are hired out
- Boat Licences licences the vessel







## The District Council Doesn't Licence ...

#### Music Copyright/Performing Rights

Under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988, permission is needed from the relevant copyright holders – those who create, record and publish music – in order to play or perform music in public.

#### Massage Parlours / Nail Bars

These are licensed in London under special treatments.

#### Other licensing

These licence types are administered by Derbyshire County Council:

- 1. Approved Wedding Ceremony Venues
- 2. Animal Movement Permits
- 3. Scaffolding on the Highway




# Local Government in Derbyshire

- DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL transport & roads, education & learning, social care and health, etc
- 8 DISTRICT/BOROUGH COUNCILS provide front line services to public
  - Derbyshire Dales District Council is one of these
- PARISH COUNCILS comment on planning applications, monitor public rights of way, street lighting, bus shelters, allotments, etc
  - 72 Parish and Town Councils in the Derbyshire Dales
- (Separate arrangements exist in the City of Derby)
- (Peak District National Park Authority has planning powers that cover half the Derbyshire Dales District)
