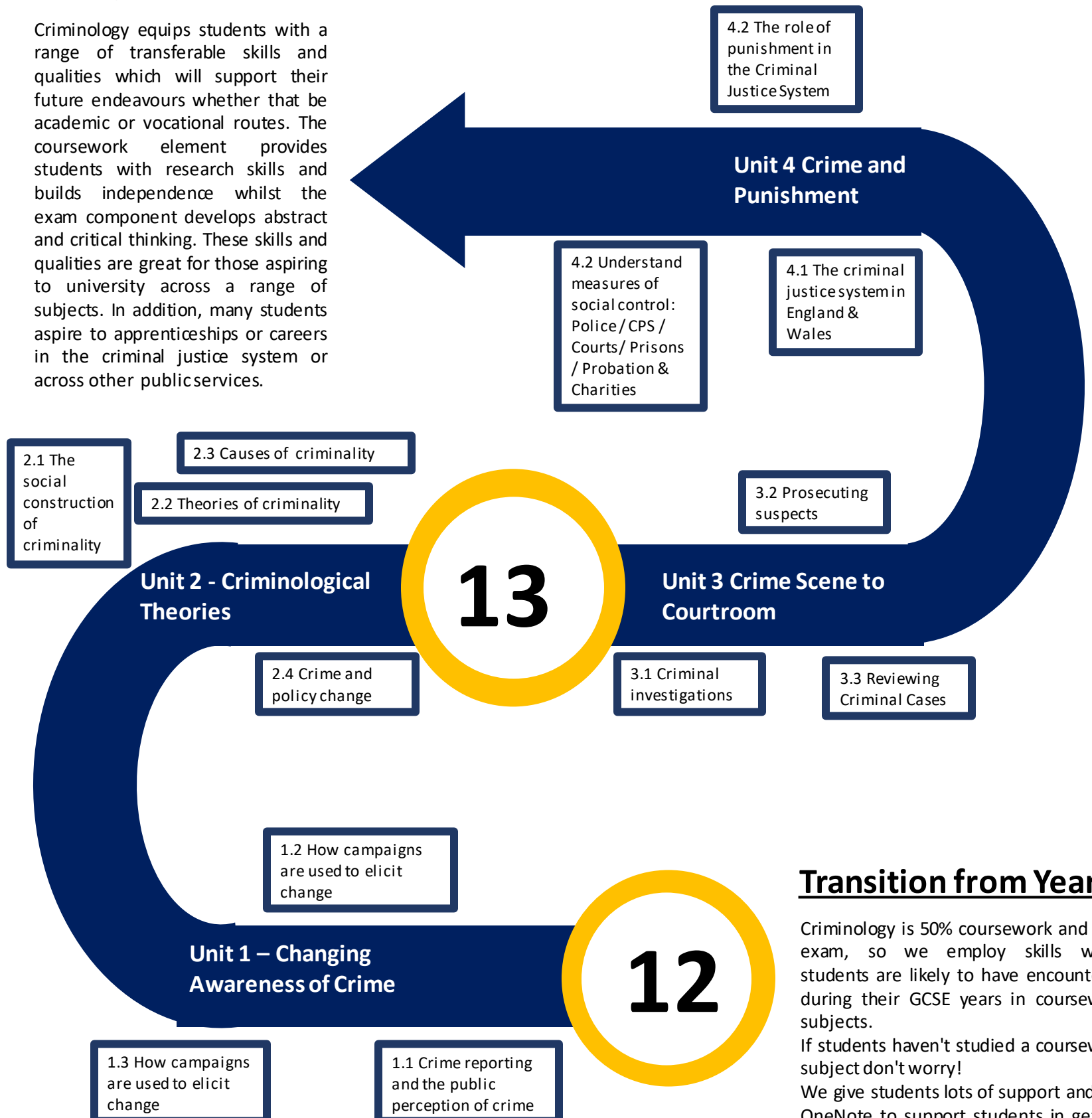




A level Criminology Learning Journey
