Course Details

Students who choose to take this subject will follow a broad based course in Art.

UNIT 1

Students will develop an Art and Design Portfolio using a variety of different media and in both 2D and 3D forms. This will include drawing, photography, painting and 3D design. Their Portfolio will include an Art history element in which the practical work of the student is linked with the work of other artists. The Portfolio is produced over the two year period and the exam is taken at the end of the course.

UNIT 2

Students select one question to which they produce a personal response through their art work and links with other artists. They are given a period of time to plan and prepare for this and then 10 hours of controlled time to produce a final piece.

The work is internally marked and externally moderated.
