The course is made up of **three** examination papers.

Component 1: Investigating Geographical Issues - 40%

Topics include: Urbanisation, Development, Global Cities, Rivers, Weather and Climate, Ecosystems, Rural – Urban Change, Coasts, Climate Change, Desertification and Water.

Component 2: Problem Solving Geography - 30%

This paper explores a current geographical issue. The paper introduces the issue and then goes on to outline possible solutions that you will analyse so you can choose and justify a solution that will hopefully solve the problem.

Component 3: Applied Fieldwork - 30%

For this component we will go on two fieldtrips during the course to learn how to conduct a good piece of fieldwork. We will set hypotheses, trial different methods of collecting data and then present our data, analyse the findings and draw conclusions from what we find. The exam is based
