Top tip – use a highlighter pen to highlight the 2 or 3 KEY words in the question

If you understand the wording of the question- you can answer it in a better way

:

Identify / state / give / name.....you just state facts and they may be one word answers. Eg

Identify 1 professional job role on a construction site, state one responsibility for

Answer

- Architect / Designing the building

State 2 responsibilities of a site manager

[2]

Answer

- Hiring and firing staff / designing menus

You do not need to use full sentences for this type of question

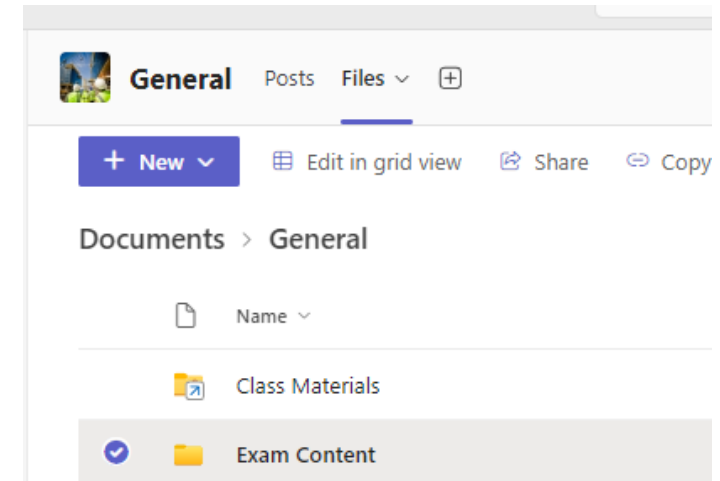
For the bigger mark questions.....

Explain / Evaluate / Discuss / Describe questions need you to PEE.







Make a POINT, EXPLAIN the point and give EXAMPLES if appropriate
